Violin Program:

Each week, students registering for violin lessons will receive a one-on-one lesson and participate in a group class. This combination allows each child to develop at their own pace while also giving them the opportunity to enjoy fun group activities that reinforce musical development, make friends, improve ensemble skills, and prepare them to do chamber music once they reach the appropriate level.

Chamber Music Coachings:

Intermediate and advanced instrumental students in the Violin Program or taking private lessons elsewhere, can request to be placed in a chamber music ensemble, usually groups of 2 to 4 musicians where each musician plays an independent part. String, wind and piano students are all encouraged to apply and will be accepted if an appropriate group can be formed.

Schedules:

Programs will run from the beginning of September to mid June during the school week, with break weeks following the school calendar. Individual lessons, group classes and chamber music will be scheduled to accommodate everyone's schedules.

Middle and Upper Master's School students can take lessons during study hall periods.
Homeschooling families can request lessons during school hours if preferred.

Rates 2026-2027:

Violin Program (billed at the beginning of each 10-week session):

- Option 1: 30-minute private lesson + 45-minute group class each week: \$600/session
- Option 2: 45-minute private lesson + 45-minute group class each week: \$800/session
- Option 3: 60-minute private lesson + 45-minute group lesson each week: \$1000/session

Chamber Music Program (billed as groups are formed):

\$1200 per student for 30 weeks of 60-minute coachings (pro-rated for any groups formed later in the year)
